Thank you for your interest in the Military Road School Donnessa Lucas Memorial Scholarship Fund Awards program.

Each year, the Military Road School Preservation Trust (MRSPT) awards one or more financial scholarships to students who permanently reside within the Washington metropolitan area and are continuing their formal education in the pursuit of an undergraduate degree. These awards are offered to assist students enrolled at an accredited college or university with the costs of books, supplies, equipment, and other education-related expenses. Qualified applicants may re-apply annually for up to four years of funding during their undergraduate studies.

Attached is an application form for the 2024 – 2025 school year. Please note that this form cannot be submitted electronically; it must be downloaded and forwarded, together with the required documentation, by regular postal mail. Completed applications must be received by **June 30**, 2024. However, if issues beyond your control impact your ability to meet this deadline, please notify us in advance of your intention to apply and the specific reasons for the delay.

Also, please be sure to <u>print legibly</u> and to provide <u>all</u> information and documents required, including your <u>official transcript</u>. **Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be returned**. Although previous recipients re-applying for a <u>consecutive</u> year are encouraged to provide information about current and relevant school-related activities they are not required to submit additional references or a personal statement. Each applicant's eligibility will be considered based solely upon the information submitted in their package. All applicants will be notified by mail regarding their eligibility status, and qualified candidates may be requested to schedule a virtual interview during the final selection process. Funds will be made available to awardees in accordance with the terms set forth in the Letter of Agreement, which will be forwarded to them. Upon receipt of the fully executed Letter of Agreement, a check for deposit into the student's account will be mailed to the appropriate financial officer of the college or university. Accordingly, no exceptions to these procedures for the disbursement of funds will be made unless all parties agree to alternative arrangements.
